Notice: Public Meeting to discuss Leesburg Stormwater Program.

The Mayor and City Council of Leesburg are seeking the public's input on drainage issues within the city. The City is preparing a long-term capital improvement plan to address chronic drainage issues within the city.

The capital improvement plan will investigate all known drainage issues and prepare preliminary engineering solutions and costs. Each project will be ranked based on scoring criterion which looks at factors such as: damage to structures, danger to public, cost, feasibility, long term maintenance. Upon completion of the capital improvement plan, the City will examine funding mechanisms to begin addressing the documented issues.

An Open House Meeting is scheduled on Tuesday, July 23rd from 5:00 PM to 7:00 to discuss the Stormwater Program. This meeting is open to the public.
