2022 Milage Rate

The City needs to set the Millage Rate for the 2022 tax year.

The overall digest for the 2022 tax year saw a substantial decrease of \$2,554,290. The largest decrease was in real property.

We have published the required five-year history and current year digest advertisement in accordance with Georgia State Code and would like to recommend that the 2022 millage rate be set at 4.669 mills.

For 2021, the millage rate was 4.665. It may appear that the recommended millage rate is an increase from 2021, however, it is not due to the changes in the digest for 2022.

The rollback millage rate for 2022 is 4.669 mills. Since the recommended millage of 4.669 is not above that of the rollback rate, this equals no increase in property taxes for 2022.

Notes for Setting 2022 Millage Rate

The City needs to set the Millage Rate for the 2022 tax year.

- The overall digest for the 2022 tax year decreased by \$2,554,290. The largest decrease is in real property.
- Personal property is down by \$89,000.
- Motor vehicles is down by \$37,000.
- The LOST rollback rate for 2022 is 4.669 mills.

We have published the required five-year history and current digest advertisement in accordance with Georgia State Code and would like to recommend that the 2022 millage rate be set at 4.669 mills.

This millage rate reflects no increase in property taxes for 2022. PT32.1 (revised April 2019)
